Acceptable HW: Acetone, Aerosols, Antifreeze, Asbestos, Automotive fluid, Batteries, Bug Spray, Chemical Cleaners, Compressed Cylinders, Corrosives, Diesel, Expired OTC Meds, Fertilizer, Fire Extinguishers, Flares, Floor Care Products, Florescent Tubes, Fungicides, Furniture Polish, Gasoline, Herbicides, Insecticides, Kerosene, Lightbulbs, Lighter Fluid, Mercury, Metallic, Moth Balls, Motor Oil, Muriatic Acid, Nail Polish, Oil, Oxidizers, Paint & Paint products, Pesticides, Polishes, Pool Chemicals, Propane Tanks, Smoke Detectors, Solvents, Thermometers, Varnish & Wood Preservatives

Electronics: Cable Box, Cell Phone, Computer, DVD/VCR, Fax Machine, Gaming Units, Laptop, Keyboards, Monitors, Mouse, Notebook, Pagers, Phones, Printers, Scanners, Stereo/Radio, Terminals, Typewriter & TV

Unacceptable Items: Air Conditioning Units, Ammunition, Acceptable items with broken glass. Appliances, Car Parts, Compost/Yard waste, Construction Debris, Dehumidifiers, Helium Tanks, Infectious Medical Waste, Plastic Shopping Bags, Prescription Drugs/Controlled Substances, Radioactive Material, Shock-sensitive Material, Standard Household Trash or Recycling, Tires & Water Heaters.
